The amazing thing is that this principle of seedtime and harvest works in the SPIRITUAL REALM as well as in the natural realm! So, when we take the seed in our hand that God gave us and sow it into His ministries, we WILL REAP A HARVEST!

Chapter 2 of *God's Answers for Your Finances* details what a seed can look like (spoiler alert: it's not always financial!) and how this principle works. In this chapter, we'll also discover what marks the covenant between us and God, just like the rainbow marked the covenant between God and Noah.

You've heard the phrase "different as night and day," right? Well, that's how different God's economy is from the world's economy. And with the roller-coaster stock market numbers and skyrocketing prices for everything from gas to milk, I'm so glad that God's economy is distinctive!

"But wait a minute," you say. "How on earth is there an economy in Heaven?" I'm so glad you asked! Here's a sneak peek at God's thoughts on how to increase your harvest:

Give, and it will be given to you; good measure, pressed down, shaken together, running over they will pour into your lap. For by your standard of measure it will be measured to you in return (Luke 6:38).

Here's how it works: If you need a friend ... be a friend. If you need money ... give money. If you need help ... assist someone else. When you act according to this Scriptural principle, the Lord pours blessings back into your life.

This week's chapter talks about a word many churchgoers have heard but may not understand: *tithe*. Basically, a tithe is "a tenth part of something paid as a voluntary contribution." Generally, a tithe is to be the *first* 10% of your income that you give to God's work.

- Have you heard the word *tithe* before? If so, what were your previous impressions?
- How do you feel about tithing now that you've read the Scriptural basis for it?

H.L.: Give to God first ... and be rewarded!

Have you ever gotten an invitation to a party ... after the host accidentally mentions it to you at the last minute? Have you ever been given a gift ... and then found the original gift tag to someone else in the bag? Those feelings of rejection and not being good enough can make you feel not so great.

But that's exactly what we do to God when we scrounge around in the couch cushions to see if we've got some change to throw in the offering plate at church.

What happens when we give to God first instead?

Honor the LORD from your wealth, and with the **first** of all your produce; your barns will be filled with plenty, and your vats will overflow with new wine (Proverbs 3:9-10 ESV).

God blesses us with an abundant harvest when we honor Him first! That's the first principle for wealth covered in chapter 4 of *God's Answers for Your Finances*.

Have you ever wondered whether it's okay to just ask God to increase your wealth? Yes! Here's what this looked like for one man:

Jabez called on the God of Israel, saying, "Oh that You would bless me indeed and enlarge my border, and that Your hand might be with me, and that You would keep me from harm that it may not pain me!" **So God granted him what he requested** (1 Chronicles 4:10).

Jehovah Jireh is our provider, and He promises that if we continually seek Him, we will "not lack any good thing" (Psalm 24:10).

So, how does this all work? Well, that's what chapter 5 in *God's Answers for Your Finances* is all about! But it's not all about the money. Remember, God cares more about YOU than He does about your bank account.

While you can't take your physical assets with you, you CAN bank on your spiritual assets! Remember: Life is short, but eternity is long! Let your priorities reflect God's eternal perspective.
